Red Letter Challenge - People who are new to the faith often ask, "How do I follow Jesus? What am I supposed to do?" Even people who have believed and followed Jesus for much of their life struggle to answer that question. What better way to answer than to focus on the very words of Jesus! During the Red Letter Challenge we will hear and apply His teaching on five main principles: **Being, Forgiving, Serving, Giving and Going**. This is an intentional step in growing deeper spiritual roots.

Starting next Sunday, we will launch a 40-day campaign that will include Sunday messages, small group studies, personal daily devotions and even a custom-designed children's program. You will want to pick up a Red Letter Challenge manual which will guide us through the entire process.
