

Did you know ... when you give to support the many ministries of First Baptist Church Charlottetown (as a registered charity) you will receive an annual tax receipt, providing we have your name and mailing address, that when applied to your income tax filing will create a tax credit of up to 43% of the amount given? For example, a donation of \$2,500.00 might save you up to \$1,075.00. However to issue an official receipt, the church has to be able to track and record your givings, so please use the many giving options we have here at First Baptist:

Giving Options at First Baptist Church

- 1) Use your numbered **offering envelopes**, an envelope from the pew, or from the Welcome Centre and place it in the collection during the Sunday service.
- 2) **Giving online using Tithe.ly** – this app allows for giving using your credit card. You can find a link on the church website, or download the app at https://tithe.ly/give_new/www/#/tithe.ly/give. If you do not wish to set up a tithe.ly account yourself, you can write your information down on a form from the pew and our Accounting Technician will input the details.
- 3) Giving through **Pre-Authorized Remittance (PAR)** – this allows for automatic giving from your bank account on weekly, bi-weekly or monthly intervals. Sign up sheets for this option can be found at the Welcome Centre.

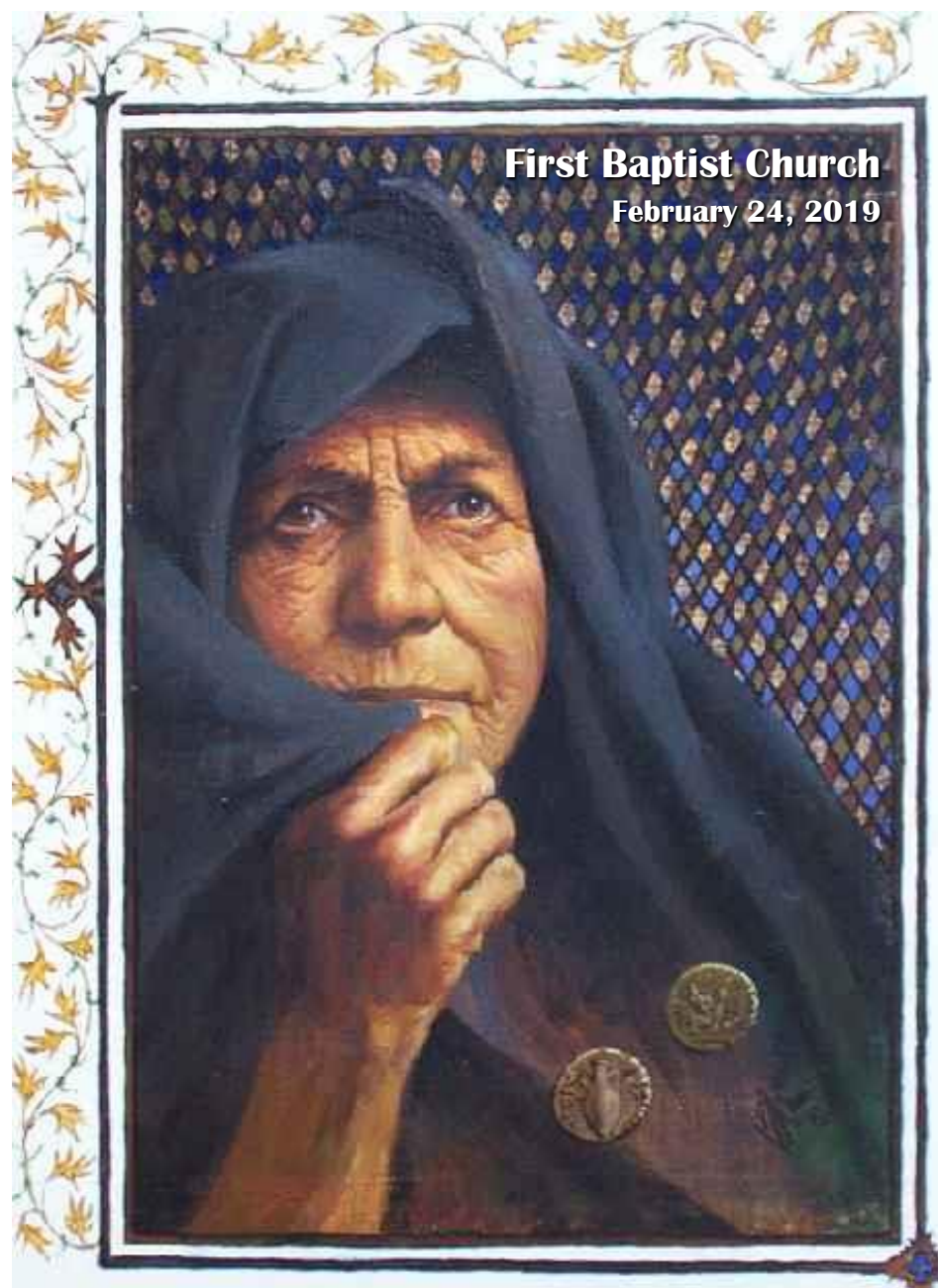
