DID YOU KNOW (a moment in First Baptist history)

That the first sexton, or custodian, of the Charlottetown Baptist Church was member JOHN BURHOE. He was hired in 1882 to **"keep the house clean, keep the fires in good style and dust the pews"**. As compensation for his efforts the church provided, **"Brooms and coal from church supplies for personal use and consumption."**
