**DID YOU KNOW** (A Moment in First Baptist History):

When the big Octagonal Baptist Church burned, the newspaper said that initially the brick structure stood, *“Despite not a drop of water being applied, as though defying the flames. Vain was the hope, however, as all became aware the church was burning within. Soon this handsome and magnificent building was a roaring furnace, presenting a spectacle at once imposing and awful.”* (Charlottetown ‘Patriot’, May 15, 1888).


