Giving Options at First Baptist Church

For your convenience in worship, we offer the following ways to give:

- 1) Use your numbered **offering envelopes**, an envelope from the pew, or from the Welcome Centre and place it in the collection during the Sunday service.
- 2) **Giving online using Tithe.ly** – this app allows for giving using your credit card. You can find a link on the church website, or download the app at https://tithe.ly/give_new/www/#/tithe.ly/give. If you do not wish to set up a tithe.ly account yourself, you can write your information down on a form from the pew and our Accounting Technician will input the details.
- 3) Giving through **Pre-Authorized Remittance (PAR)** – this allows for automatic giving on weekly, bi-weekly or monthly intervals. Sign up sheets for this option can be found at the Welcome Centre.
